If I were still trying to please men, I would not be a **servant** of Christ. Galatians 1:10

but made himself nothing, taking the very nature of a **servant**, Philippians 2:7

Epaphras, who is one of you and a **servant** of Christ Jesus, sends greetings. He is always wrestling in prayer for you, that you may stand firm in all the will of God, mature and fully assured. Colossians 4:12

And the Lord's **servant** must not quarrel; instead, he must be kind to everyone, able to teach, not resentful. 25Those who oppose him he must gently instruct, in the hope that God will grant them repentance leading them to a knowledge of the truth, 2 Timothy 2:24-25
